### **2020 Activity fee and Donations**

The school will soon be sending out statements and reminders for the 2020 Activity fee and donations, so it is timely to highlight the importance of these and what they are used for. While

the government pays for education, as a decile 10z school we receive the lowest funding per pupil in the country, which barely covers the basics. Without your contribution, we would not have the same ability to maintain existing class sizes and provide learning support, extension opportunities and enriching options such as creative arts. Importantly, your donation contributes to additional teaching staff, as well as a range of support staff such as our librarian and teacher aides and sports coordinator to benefit all children. It also contributes towards additional library books, reading resources, art and craft supplies and sports equipment.

It is our vision that all Muritai children reach their fullest potential. With your support, the Board aims to provide the best possible environment for all students to flourish and be successful in achieving their goals.
