Thank you to everyone who made the time to meet with their child's classroom teacher for Learning Conversations this week. The teachers really enjoyed connecting with you all to share more about the progress the ākonga have made over the first half of the term.

A reminder, you are welcome to connect with us at any time about your child's learning, even if it is outside these formal reporting window opportunities.

The classes across the school have settled nicely into the learning programmes for Term 3. It is always a treat visiting the classrooms and observing the variety of learning experiences that are taking place. I've been very impressed with the solid routines all the classrooms are in, particularly our youngest learners in Kororā. They are focused on their learning and have a good understanding of what it means to be a successful learner.

One of our key focuses for Muritai School this year has been promoting what it means to have a positive behaviour for learning (PB4L). There are a number of initiatives we implement to ensure we have success with this, all of which are connected to our Living 'BEST' Values of Being KIND, RESPECTFUL, RESILIENT with a sense of TOGETHERNESS. We are very proud to promote these values and endeavour to use them in our everyday language to promote success and achievement. We also use them for when things don't go so well or conflicts arise, and to help restore relationships or grow our learners. Throughout the year we have been unpacking what these values mean and how they look and sound in different contexts.
